Top 10 Benefits of a Hosted Server for Businesses

- 1. Scalability: Pay for as little or as much space as you need.
- 2. Flexibility: Ability to flex your environment, set up test environments, or expand quickly to accommodate growth.
- 3. Real Estate: Is your bulky server currently taking up precious space that could be better utilized for something else? Eliminate the need for bulky (unattractive) equipment by operating through a Data Center.
- 4. Site-to-Site Connectivity: Ability to connect multiple site locations and remote/mobile employees to a centralized shared server without compromising security.
- 5. 24/7/365 Monitoring and Support: Rest assured knowing that your systems are working and that someone is watching over their home. If something does need attention, you should have skilled technicians available whenever you need help.
- 6. Security & Compliance: Secure access and 24/7/365 monitoring are just the beginning. As the risk of cyber threats increase, so do the consequences of failing to meet the stringent requirements imposed by HIPPA, PCI, and SSAE standards
